More Faith-full in Connecting

More Faith-Full in His will

- Reading the Bible or devotional material

Within and Beyond the Church

More Faith-full in Sharing Good News

Think of a time when Jesus has guided or helped you. Think of what your faith means to you. How comfortable are you in sharing these thoughts with someone who doesn't know Jesus as Lord?

If you feel uncomfortable or unsure, who or what resources might be helpful?
